



## After the Bell - Jefferson County After School Program Information and FAQ

Hours: After school 2:50PM - 6:00PM

**Open on early release days:** 12:50PM - 6:00PM (Extended hours included in tuition)

**Open on non-school days:** Depending on the need (and staffing)

**Enrollment Options:** Part-time (up to 3-days / Week) and full-time (up to 5-days / week)

- → Part time families can choose any 3 days of the week and this can vary each week if needed
- → Families are responsible for notifying staff in advance of any schedule changes so they can plan for the appropriate staffing, snacks, and supplies

**Structure:** A balanced mix of structured time and free play, play-based learning, healthy snacks, hands-on curriculum activities, homework/academic support, and social engagement with children of various ages.

**Family Membership:** Fees include a Household Membership to all branches of the Olympic Peninsula YMCA for the duration of their child's enrollment in the licensed child care program. That's a \$96 value, roughly \$1,000 for the school year!

## Benefits of a licensed program:

- → Meets state safety and health standards, with regular inspections
- → Staff are trained, background-checked, and meet education and professional development requirements
- → Classrooms follow age-appropriate curriculum, structure, and maintain safe child-to-teacher ratios
- → We can accept state and military subsidies

**Subsidy Information:** Washington State is committed to ensuring qualifying families do not pay more than 7% of their income on child care - All families encouraged to apply for subsidy through the state
